

# The Following Rules will be used to Rank the Cards

There are 52 cards in the pack and the ranking of the individual cards, from high to ace, king, queen, jack, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, joker. There is no ranking between the suits – for example the king of hearts and the king of spades are equal and the joker card is wild. The joker wild card to be given to those who visit all subdivisions. Each subdivision will have a location to get a playing card and ticket for door prizes.

Players will be allowed to change their hand (with the object of improvit it) by discarding the unwated cards. Going to more locations improves your chance for a better hand, plus give you more chances to win door prizes.

A poker hand consists of five cards and the participants can throw extra cards out if they have went to all subdivisions. The categories of a hand, from highest to lowest are listed below. Any hand in a higher category beats any hand in a lower category (for example a three of a kind beat any 2 pairs). Between hand in the same category, the rank of the individual cards decides which hand is better.

Categories:

1. Royal Flush
2. Straight Flush
3. Four of a Kind
4. Full House
5. Flush
6. Straight
7. Three of a Kind
8. 2 Pairs
9. Pair
10. High Card
